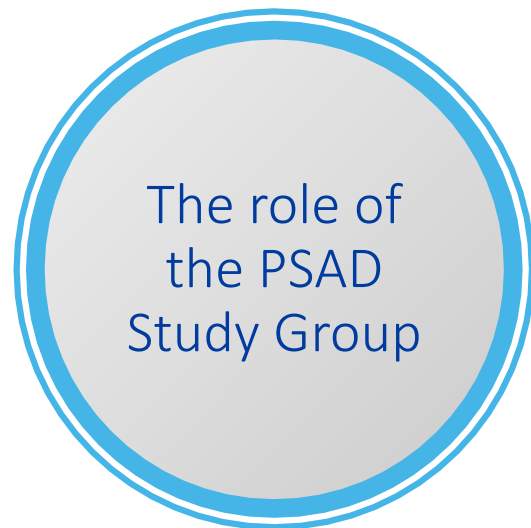

- Retired professionals

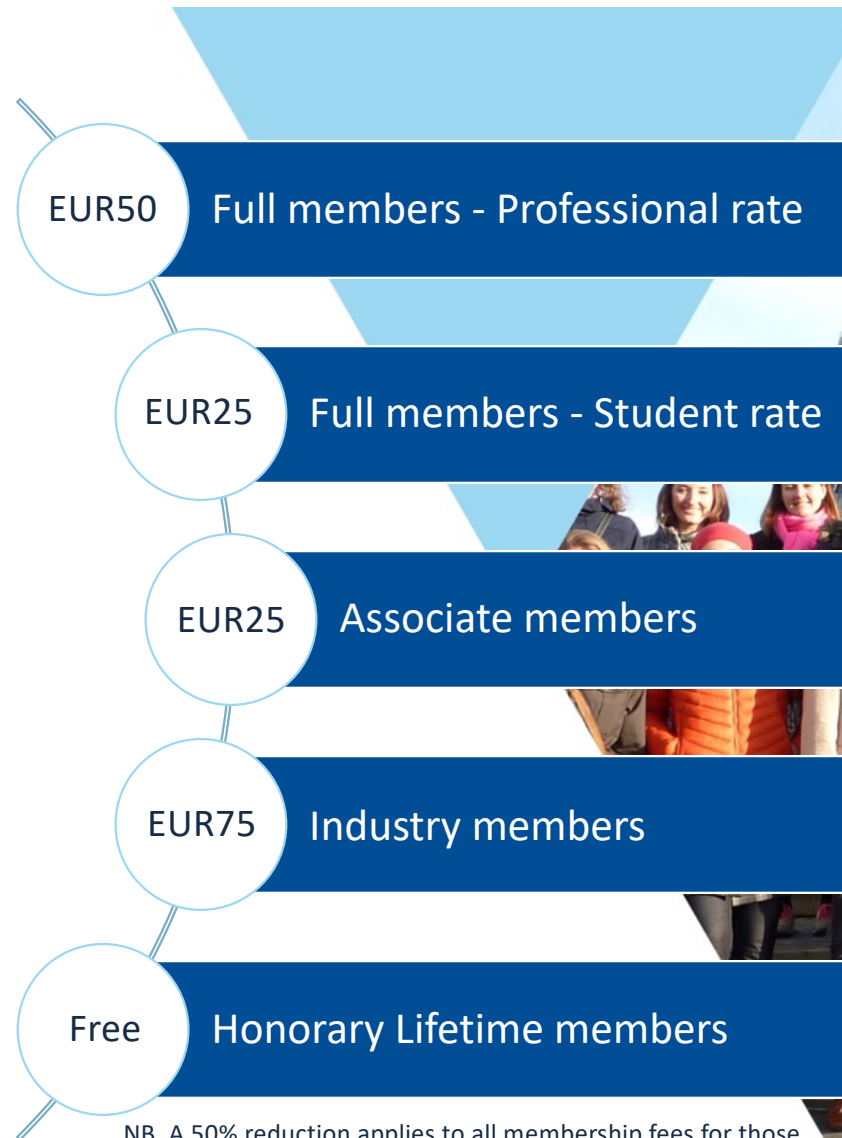
Industry members
